

## **Possible PCSPIM Fix**

**I believe the problem people are having with installing PCSPIM on their laptops is due to 64 bit windows. Once the program is installed using the default settings, it attempts to locate a file called exceptions.s when you try and run PCSPIM. The problem is that it is looking for it in the folder c:\Program Files\ instead of c:\Program Files (x86)\. Since most people's laptops are newer than their desktops, this would be why it appears to only effect laptops.**

**The easy fix for this is to run PCSPIM and click yes the error message pops up that asks you if you would like to change the settings. At the bottom of the window that pops up is a file path for the file exceptions.s. Add (x86) after program files in the file path and click OK. PCSPIM should work fine after this.**
