This is to inform you that your manuscript, "What Drives New Ventures to Internationalize from Emerging to Developed Economies?", ranked among the top five *ET&P* downloads from Wiley-Blackwell Synergy in 2008. According to the 2008 Wiley-Blackwell publisher's report, your article was accessed 1045 times. The editorial office at *Entrepreneurship Theory & Practice* congratulates you and recognizes the significance of such an accomplishment.

Our journal is an interdisciplinary, scholarly journal for conceptual and empirical research that develops, tests or extends theory relating to entrepreneurship, including small and family firm issues. It has been consistently recognized by the *Financial Times* as one of the top 35 (now 50) most influential business journals and is also included in the *Social Science Citation Index* (SSCI). Our most recent Impact Factor Rating of 1.8+ ranked us as number 13 of the 72 ranked business journals. The *Academy of Management Journal* (5.0) was 1st, the *Strategic Management Journal* (2.8+) was 6th, the *Journal of Management* (2.0) was 9th and the *Harvard Business Review* (1.3+) was 23rd, for example.

The journal has subscribers throughout the United States and in over 60 countries around the world, and it has been adopted as the official journal of the United States Association for Small Business and Entrepreneurship. It is abstracted and indexed by most major vendors and in a variety of forms, including on-line and CD-ROM formats.
