Online coursework at UTD is delivered through eLearning at <https://elearning.utdallas.edu>. You'll need your UTD NetID (assigned when you enroll) and password.

If you are a new student, please activate your account at <http://netid.utdallas.edu>.

Your textbook can be ordered online through [Off-Campus Books](#) or the [UTD Bookstore](#) or any other site that you prefer. They may also be purchased at the UTD Bookstore and Off-Campus Books Bookstore.

If your purchase is delayed, there are reserve copies available at the UTD Library and the publisher's site (<http://pearsonhighered.com>) may offer an online preview.

You'll need your 8-digit UTD-ID number to access UTD library electronic resources remotely. Please see <http://www.utdallas.edu/library/distlearn/disted.htm> for details.

To access your eLearning course:

1. Log in at <https://elearning.utdallas.edu>
2. Click the "Check Browser" button to validate your web browser for eLearning.
3. Click on "Academic"
4. Click "Log In"
5. Enter your UTD NetID and Password into the fields (case sensitive). Click the "OK" button.
6. You will see a page showing a list of all courses that you are enrolled in. To enter a course, click the course title link and you will see the Course Content page.

What to do after entering your eLearning course:

1. The first page you see when you enter your course is the Course Content (Home) page which contains several icons.
2. The Course Menu on the left side lists all available tools and items.
3. Please thoroughly read the course syllabus and then check all the areas in the course to become familiar with the features and contents of the course.
4. You can click on the "Help" option at the top right of each course page to access information related to that page or tool.
