III. UT DALLAS ELECTIVE REQUIREMENTS: 3 semester credit hours

Internship:

A pre-approved Internship is required for all Naveen Jindal School of Management majors.

Must register for internship credit for 0-3 semester credit hours.

Community Engagement Experience:

A community engagement experience is required for all Naveen Jindal School of Management majors.

Must register for community engagement experience credit for 0 or 3 semester credit hours.

Free Electives:

Both lower-division and upper-division courses may count as electives.

But students must complete at least 51 semester credit hours of upper-division courses to qualify for graduation.

A MINIMUM OF 128 SEMESTER CREDIT HOURS IS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION WITH AT LEAST 11 UPPER-DIVISION SEMESTER CREDIT HOURS.

Transfer Core options listed reflect the TCCNS courses only, as approved at UT DALLAS.

Other Texas public colleges or universities may individually interpret some TCCNS courses in a different core category,

which UT DALLAS will honor. Check with a UT DALLAS academic advisor to verify this.

Other courses that may potentially qualify for core requirements must be approved by a UT DALLAS academic advisor

or the department housing the student's major.

Completion of the entire Core Curriculum at another Texas public college or university will substitute for

completion of UT DALLAS' Core Curriculum.

TCCNS courses in Field of Study (FOS) programs will transfer to UT DALLAS.

UT DALLAS does not accept vocational or technical courses in certificate or applied science programs,

nor Workforce Education (WECM) courses, nor developmental courses.
