

## What's Included in the Pediatric Dental Plans for Student Health?

The Affordable Care Act mandated that health insurance plans contain certain Essential Health Benefits (EHBs). Below is a list of benefits included in pediatric dental plans for student health.

### Benefits covered<sup>1</sup> up to age 19:

#### Pediatric dental includes:

- Unlimited maximums (annual and/or orthodontia lifetime; in-network and out-of-network)
- Individual deductible \$75/family deductible \$225
- Yearly out-of-pocket maximum of \$700 for one child, \$1,400 for two or more children (maximum family out-of-pocket: \$1,400)

Note: Whether a family plan is selected, or a "child-only" plan is selected, all of these benefits are covered.
